International Telecommunication Union (ITU) World Radiocommunication Conferences (WRCs) are held approximately every four years to review and revise the international Radio Regulations (RR). Last year WRC-19 was held from 28th Oct to 22nd Nov 2019 in Sharm El Sheikh, Egypt with more than 3400 Delegates from the 196 ITU member states.

This talk gives a summary of the outcome of the main Agenda Items of interest to Australian mobile industry including global and regional identification of mmWave bands for the deployment of 5G networks, while also adopting measures to ensure appropriate protection of the existing services.
