NBN Co losses for year mount to \$3.3b as users rise to 3.7m

NBN Co has recorded a loss of \$3.3 billion in the nine months to March 2018, the third quarter of the current financial year. This compares to a loss of \$2.7 billion for the nine months of the previous financial year.

Telstra takes ZTE devices off its shelves

Telstra has stopped selling ZTE mobiles and mobile broadband devices from today, following an export ban imposed on the company in the US which prevents it from buying components from American suppliers.

ACCC lauds speed lift for NBN users, says competition for services increases
