Flight Lieutenant Andrew Sibenaler will talk about the capabilities of the AP-3C Orion aircraft.

The tour will be conducted in the Thales AP-3C flight simulator, a fully articulated hydraulic Category 5 simulator.

Attendees will have the chance to use the flight simulator to attempt a take-off, fly around and landing.
